Theme: Police reform in Sierra Leone: Successes and challenges

27th February 2008: A two-day conference on the successes and challenges of police reform in Sierra Leone is to be held on the 4th-5th March at the Bintumani Hotel in Freetown.

The conference is organized by Forum of Conscience (FOC) in collaboration with the Centre for Law Enforcement Education-CLEEN Foundation based in Nigeria.

The two day conference on the theme ‘Police Reform in Sierra Leone-Successes and Challenges’ is geared to facilitate dialogue between stakeholders on police and policing reform and also review on-going Police reform in Sierra Leon which started from the year 2000 to date.

The sessions will deliberate on issues including the effectiveness of the legislative framework for the Sierra Leone Police, successes and challenges of the SLP’s post conflict experiences and also discuss the role of civil society in on-going police reform processes.

Representatives from the Centre for Law Enforcement Education-CLEEN Foundation will share experiences in Justice Sector reform and policing in Nigeria.

The Minister of Internal Affairs, Hon. Dauda Kamara is to officially open the conference and deliver the keynote address.
